Thank you.

This year marks the 9th year of this Global FundWomen Week ("GFWW"), which was started by two female fund managers in California who, saw a problem and, as women do, created a solution. They recognized there was nothing in place to channel capital specifically to women-run investment funds. In 2014, those two women brought together 14 allocators and 14 managers for the first 100 Women in Finance conference. The conference has grown since then, and this year I'm thrilled that we had over 300 female-led fund managers and over 200 allocators participating in Global FundWomen Week. Through our in-person New York conference, and our 45 virtual sessions, participants had ample opportunities to expand their LP and GP networks, learn from other another and raise capital.

Fundamental to this conference is the belief that institutional allocators will create better outcomes for their underlying beneficiaries by having more female representation in their manager roster. We know the data indicates women and diverse led teams make better investment decisions and produce better returns, yet women remain massively underrepresented in portfolios. The women that participate in GFWW represent some of the best in our industry, and in addition to their outstanding returns, they are resilient, strong and have endured battles that their male counterparts just have not had to. They are exactly the type of individuals we should want managing our capital.

You are critical to that mission – either as female-led managers, or as allocators who recognize these managers will benefit your portfolios. Even beyond one such portfolios, I hope this report illustrates the power of women in finance, and the need to continue to invest in their development and growth.

We have been extremely fortunate to have partnered with IADEI (Institutional Allocators for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion), who have provided incredible support for the conference. Thank you also to our technology partner CLADE, who has gathered data on all the female-led funds participating, so we can continue to monitor the performance of these managers and download their materials year round.

Finally, I want to thank the volunteers who donated their time to organizing these events. Their efforts were essential in attracting the LPs, GPs and speakers to this event. Most of these volunteers do not work for female led funds, but they devoted countless hours to help level the playing field for women in this industry.

As you read over this report, I hope you are energized by the incredible female investment talent taking part in GFWW. If you are an allocator, I hope you are active in engaging with managers and consider many of them for inclusion in your portfolio.

If we can all raise the profile for female led funds, we won't be fighting over our 0.7% slice of the institutional allocation pie. We'll be fighting for all 100% of it.




